COLD WEATHER SHELTER 2024

New Details about the Cold Weather Shelter (CWS): The CWS is a combined effort of Grassroots Crisis Center, Howard County Government and local congregations to provide food and shelter to about 40 unhoused adults and children from late November through March. For December, the Shelter will be in a hotel.

For January through March, it will be at the Day Resource Center (DRC), 10390 Guilford Road, Jessup. Our congregation is signed up to provide meals and evening volunteers for the week of Monday-Sunday, February 5-11, 2024. Volunteer Opportunities:

- 2 Evening Volunteers each night from 5:30 8:00 p.m. to help everything run smoothly
- Groups to prepare, bring, and serve a hot dinner at 6:00 p.m. at the DRC
- Assemble 40 bagged breakfasts you provide napkins, fruit, and breakfast bars, the church provides all else (bags, drinks, etc.)
- Assemble 40 bagged lunches you provide napkins, deli meat, and fruit, the church provides all else (bags, bread, cheese, drinks, etc.)
- Note: Bagged breakfasts and lunches need to be dropped off at the DRC by 6:00 p.m. or at the church by 4:00 p.m.
