#### FEBRUARY IS BLACK HISTORY MONTH.

The National Theme for Black History Month this year is *African Americans and the Arts*. Black contributions to the visual arts have often been ignored leaving a rich tapestry of art to be rediscovered and enjoyed. American forms of music are largely built on the contributions of African Americans. From spirituals, to gospels, to rock and roll to hip-hip, to rap, America has been greatly enriched by Black musicians. While it's very difficult for FPCHC to secure the rights to display visual art by famous Black artists, we can secure the rights to perform music by Black composers. #### MAKING SPACE FOR GOD - taught by Bruce

This class will center around practicing today's science-based mindfulness, known as Mindfulness Based Stress Reduction (MBSR). MBSR has been used since 1970 as a method for relieving stress as well as helping persons with extreme chronic pain and depression. Tim Stead's book, Mindfulness and Christian Spirituality will be the major source for our practice and discussion. Stead is an Anglican priest and also a trained teacher of mindfulness.

Class members will also be asked to alter a life habit during Lent as a means of enhancing daily mindfulness of the season. The book, <u>Mindfulness and Christian Spirituality</u> is now available for purchase from DCE Virginia Callegary for \$15.00 and will be essential for class participation. 

# ASH WEDNESDAY, February 14, 2024 The Beginning of Lent

Worship in-person at 7:00 p.m. in the sanctuary A service of prayer, song, and ashes.



This is a service of prayer, meditation, song, and the traditional imposition of ashes to help us mark the beginning of Lent as a congregation, and as individual disciples of Jesus. Lent is a time for self-reflection as we make ready for the journey inward and journey outward moving toward Easter.

#### **LENTEN DEVOTIONALS**

For Families with Children – This year each family with children can pick up a copy of <u>'Twas the Season of Lent</u> by Glenys Nellist. <u>'Twas the Season of Lent</u> is a 40-day devotional and storybook that explores the life, words, and works of Jesus and encourages families with children to draw closer to God during the Lenten Season. Each story and accompanying prayer prompt encourages children to try to be more like Jesus and do what God calls them to do.
